ENHANCED LESSON



Students will work cooperatively to develop and implement ideas to help create a more inclusive classroom environment.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of this lesson, learners will understand the:

- Students will use inquiry based learning, critical learning and critical literacy learning to gain a deeper understanding of the issues they are examining. They will explore and evaluate complex issues, analyze, apply and evaluate possible solutions.
- Students will improve their ability to participate in healthy relationships as they develop self-awareness skills, conflict-resolution skills, build empathy, cope with challenges, persevere, and develop critical and creative thinking skills
- The activities in this program follow integrative learning principles that combine current Ontario curriculum links with valuable citizenship skills like empathy, collaboration and cooperation, democratic decision-making and inclusivity.
